Today, she represents British Columbia in the Senate of Canada. She will be speaking about how her international work supports the Sustainable Development Goals.



Cecilia Maroño is country manager for Oikocredit in Uruguay and has worked in micro credit in South America since 2005. She will be talking to us about her work and how microcredit has grown and changed and how its future fits in with the Sustainable Development Goals.
